

Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will I have to work Holidays?

A: Yes, we require apprentices to work EVERY holiday during their stay, expect to work the entire day although most often it is less hours.

Q: Is it 6-days a week every week?

A: Yes, Saturday is the only day off and apprentices work Sunday-Friday.

Q: After the work day ends at 4 PM is anything else required?

A: Yes, sometimes apprentices will have to do nightly chores— this can include evening chicken checks, sheep checks during lambing season, late night preparations for slaughter, and more.

Q: Traveling to farm?

A: Upon acceptance we will advise you on how to get to Apricot Lane Farms.

Q: Am I allowed to drive a personal vehicle to the farm for my stay?

A: Yes, there is parking near the apprentice house for those who wish to bring their own vehicle.

Q: What do I need to bring?

A: We will send you a packing list upon acceptance to the apprenticeship program.

Q: How many apprentices are accepted for each 6-month program?

A: We accept three farm apprentices per program period.

Q: Is there an age requirement

A: Yes, we require applicants to be at least 21 years of age.

Q: Can I bring pets?

A: Unfortunately, we cannot allow pets.

Q: Will insurance be provided?

A: We are providing health insurance through Kaiser beginning after the first 60 days of employment.

Q: Can my family/children join me?

A: Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate for children— couples may apply, see below.

Q: Can couples apply?

A: Couples can apply together, however, both must apply separately and get accepted into the program.
